7 An Act relating to health benefit plans; directing
8 Oklahoma Insurance Department to analyze certain
9 policies; requiring report by certain date; providing
10 for codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6060.9c of Title 36, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The Oklahoma Insurance Department shall analyze discrepancies
16 between coverage for prescription drugs with abuse-deterrent
17 properties and coverage for prescription opioids without abuse-
18 deterrent properties. Such information shall be submitted in a
19 report to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of
20 the House of Representatives on or before December 31, 2017.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.

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
