6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Medicaid Program;  
8 directing Oklahoma Health Care Authority to terminate  
9 certain activities; requiring legislative approval  
10 for certain functions; providing for noncodification;  
11 providing an effective date; and declaring an  
12 emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
15 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

16 The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall cease all activities,  
17 contracts, promulgated rules and similar functions relating to the  
18 implementation of care coordination models for aged, blind and  
19 disabled persons as provided by House Bill 1566 of the 1st Session  
20 of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature. No activities, contracts or rules  
21 promulgated by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board pursuant to  
22 House Bill 1566 of the 1st Session of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature,  
23 including but not limited to rules or activities relating to  
24 requests for proposals or requests for quotes, shall be effective  
without the affirmative approval of the Legislature.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.

2 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
3 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
