7 An Act relating to identity theft; amending 22 O.S.
8 2011, Section 19a, which relates to the arrest or
9 charge as a result of identity theft; modifying
10 inclusions; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 22 O.S. 2011, Section 19a, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 19a. Notwithstanding any provision of Section 18 or 19
15 of ~~Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title, when a charge is
16 dismissed because the court finds that the defendant has been
17 arrested or charged as a result of the defendant's name or other
18 identification having been appropriated or used without the
19 defendant's consent or authorization by another person, the court
20 dismissing the charge may, upon motion of the district attorney or
21 the defendant or upon the court's own motion, enter an order for
22 expungement of law enforcement and court records relating to the
23 charge. The order shall contain a statement that the dismissal and
24 expungement are ordered pursuant to this section, and any fees

1 resulting from the charge shall be dismissed. An order entered
2 pursuant to this section shall be subject to the provisions of
3 subsections D through M of Section 19 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma
4 Statutes.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.

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
