6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Medicaid Program;  
8 authorizing reimbursement for certain services under  
9 certain circumstances; limiting eligibility for  
10 reimbursement; directing promulgation of rules;  
11 providing for codification; and providing an  
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-900 of Title 63, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall reimburse providers  
18 for quantitative drug testing when:

19 1. The absolute value of a drug in a patient will have an  
20 impact on clinical decision-making;

21 2. Such testing is used to establish a baseline for providers  
22 prescribing narcotic drugs;

23 3. A provider has reason to believe that non-prescribed drugs  
24 are being used by a patient; or

1 4. A provider has reason to believe that the patient is not  
2 adhering to the existing treatment plan.

3 B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall only reimburse  
4 facilities accredited by the College of American Pathologists and  
5 without a direct or indirect financial relationship with any  
6 provider in the Oklahoma Medicaid Program and prescribing narcotic  
7 drugs.

8 C. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate  
9 rules to implement the provisions of this act.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
