6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to environment and natural resources;
8 amending 27A O.S. 2011, Section 2-7-120, which
9 relates to liquid waste disposal; correcting certain
10 reference; modifying fee for certain waste disposal
11 into underground injection wells; and declaring an
12 emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 27A O.S. 2011, Section 2-7-120, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 2-7-120. Any person subject to regulation by the
17 Department of Environmental Quality disposing of liquid waste other
18 than hazardous waste in an underground injection well that is
19 required to be permitted shall pay a fee of two-hundredths of one
20 cent ~~(0.002)~~ (0.02) per gallon for such disposal, provided that the
21 total fee shall be not less than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00)
22 nor more than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) per year. The
23 total fee for injection of drinking water treatment residuals into a
24 Class V underground injection well shall be not less than Two
Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) nor more than Five Thousand Dollars

1 (\$5,000.00) per year. ~~Said~~ The fee shall be paid to the Department
2 on a quarterly basis within one (1) month following the close of
3 each quarter for the waste disposed in that preceding quarter. ~~Said~~
4 The fees shall be deposited into the Department of Environmental
5 Quality Revolving Fund.

6 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
