6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to collective bargaining; prohibiting  
8 collective bargaining agreements for certain police  
9 officer terminations; providing for appeal to  
10 district court; stating eligibility for  
11 reinstatement; providing for codification; and  
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 51-101.1 of Title 11, unless  
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. For all collective bargaining agreements authorized pursuant  
18 to Section 51-101 et seq. of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes  
19 entered on or after the effective date of this act, such collective  
20 bargaining agreements shall include a provision specifying the  
21 collective bargaining agreement shall not apply to police officers  
22 that were found to have used excessive force in performing their  
23 duties and were terminated for that act.

24 B. Any officer seeking relief to appeal his or her termination  
for use of excessive force may petition the district court. The

1 officer may be eligible for reinstatement if the court determines  
2 such termination was based on an arbitrary, capricious, or any other  
3 basis prohibited by law.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
