6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; directing the State
8 Department of Education, in certain collaboration, to
9 make certain information regarding workplace safety
10 training available to school districts; directing the
11 State Department of Education to encourage school
12 districts to inform certain teachers about the
13 importance of certain incorporation; directing
14 promulgation of rules; providing for codification;
15 providing an effective date; and declaring an
16 emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.6j of Title 70, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. The State Department of Education, in collaboration with the
22 Oklahoma Department of Labor, shall make available to school
23 districts information regarding workplace safety training for grades
24 seven through twelve. Such information shall include the Oklahoma
Department of Labor's "Youth @ Work Talking Safety: A Safety and
Health Curriculum for Young Workers".

1 B. The State Department of Education shall encourage school
2 districts to inform grade-seven through -twelve teachers about the
3 importance of incorporating workplace safety training in their
4 curriculum.

5 C. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to
6 implement the provisions of this act.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.

8 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
