6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Medicaid Program;  
8 directing Oklahoma Health Care Authority to contract  
9 for certain purposes; providing guidelines for audit;  
10 requiring certain provisions in contract; directing  
11 promulgation of rules; providing for noncodification;  
and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
14 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

15 A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall contract for an  
16 independent audit to identify ineligible participants in the  
17 Oklahoma Medicaid Program. The purpose of the audit shall be to  
18 identify, investigate, and resolve potential cases of fraud,  
19 misrepresentation or inadequate documentation prior to determining  
20 an applicant's eligibility for assistance under the Oklahoma  
21 Medicaid Program. The contract for the audit required by this act  
22 shall ensure that the audit analyze the eligibility of all  
23 participants in the Oklahoma Medicaid Program.

1 B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate  
2 rules to implement the provisions of this act.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
