7 An Act relating to liability; providing exemption
8 from liability for certain acts; providing exception;
9 providing for codification; and providing an
10 effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 33.1 of Title 76, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Any person who in good faith renders or attempts to render
16 emergency assistance to a person in physical distress in a locked
17 vehicle shall not be liable for civil damages or subject to criminal
18 prosecution as a result of damage caused to such vehicle in
19 rendering or attempting to render such assistance, except for gross
20 negligence or willful or wanton conduct committed in rendering the
21 assistance.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
