SENATE BILL 356

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to oil and gas; providing for prevailing parties to recover certain legal fees and costs; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 904 of Title 52, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The prevailing party in any action which is subject to the provisions of the Energy Litigation Reform Act shall be entitled to recover reasonable attorney fees, costs, and litigation expenses.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
