6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to crime and punishment; amending 21
8 O.S. 2011, Section 540, which relates to obstructing
9 an officer; stating certain allowances; and providing
10 an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 540, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 540. Any person who willfully delays or obstructs any
15 public officer in the discharge or attempt to discharge any duty of
16 his or her office, is guilty of a misdemeanor. Nothing in this
17 section shall preclude a person from recording the activity of law
18 enforcement in a public area, as long as the recording activity does
19 not impede the law enforcement agent in his or her duties. A person
20 who is recording shall be deemed to assume the risks inherent to the
21 circumstances present at the time, and neither the state nor
22 relevant political subdivision shall be liable for any injury, loss
23 or claim resulting from the recording, unless the loss was sustained
24 from the negligent affirmative act of law enforcement.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
