7 An Act relating to county sheriffs; requiring persons  
8 seeking expungement of criminal records to pay fee;  
9 stating fee; providing for deposit of fees into  
certain account; providing for codification; and  
providing an effective date.

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 514.6 of Title 19, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 All expungement orders which are presented to the office of a  
17 county sheriff for alterations to criminal history records must be  
18 accompanied by a payment of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00)  
19 payable to the office of the county sheriff. The subject of the  
20 criminal history, whose record is being amended or updated based  
21 upon an expungement order, is responsible for such payment. Payment  
22 shall be rendered before any expungement order may be processed by  
23 the office of the county sheriff. All fees collected pursuant to  
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1 this section shall be deposited in the Sheriff's Service Fee  
2 Account.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.  
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
