SENATE BILL 422

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to labor; creating the Voluntary Veterans' Preference Act; providing short title; permitting an employer voluntary veterans' preference employment policy; defining terms; requiring certain policy be in writing and uniformly applied; requiring certain documents be submitted to employer; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1314 of Title 25, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This act shall be known as and may be cited as the "Voluntary Veterans' Preference Act".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1314.1 of Title 25, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. For purposes of this act, unless the context requires otherwise:

1 1. "DD 214" means a Department of Defense Report of Separation  
2 Form or its predecessor or successor forms;

3 2. "Veterans' preference employment policy" means an employer's  
4 voluntary preference for hiring, promoting or retaining a veteran;  
5 and

6 3. "Veteran" means a person who has been honorably discharged  
7 from the Armed Forces of the United States.

8 B. An employer may have a voluntary veterans' preference  
9 employment policy.

10 C. The veterans' preference employment policy:

11 1. Shall be in writing; and

12 2. Shall be applied uniformly to employment decisions regarding  
13 the hiring, promotion, or retention during a reduction in force.

14 D. A veteran shall submit a DD 214 of the veteran to an  
15 employer with a veterans' preference employment policy to be  
16 eligible for the preference.

17 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
