6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to county officer training programs;
8 amending 19 O.S. 2011, Section 130.7, which relates
9 to educational training for certain county officers;
10 requiring training provided by or approved by certain
11 university program; specifying effective date; and
12 declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 130.7, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 130.7. A. Each county commissioner, county clerk,
17 county treasurer, and court clerk holding office on ~~the effective~~
18 ~~date of this act~~ May 11, 1982, and those elected thereafter and the
19 deputies of such elected county officers shall be required to
20 participate in the appropriate training programs, as defined in
21 subsection B of this section, and educational seminars relevant to
22 their positions and duties conducted pursuant to Sections 130.1
23 through 130.7 of this title. In addition, county sheriffs and
24 county assessors may attend the training programs specified in this
section.

1 B. Appropriate training programs shall consist of those
2 programs offered through the Cooperative Extension Service at
3 Oklahoma State University or any other training program administered
4 through an organization or association approved by the Cooperative
5 Extension Service at Oklahoma State University.

6 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
