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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to Advanced Metering Infrastructure
8 (AMI); prohibiting utilities from levying penalty for
9 non-participation in certain programs; requiring
replacement of certain AMI without penalty; providing
for codification; and providing an effective date.

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 720.4 of Title 17, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Any demand response programs for electric service offered by
17 any public utility and authorized by the Corporation Commission
18 shall be optional for residential and commercial customers.

19 B. Upon the effective date of this act, public utilities shall
20 be prohibited from levying a penalty upon any customer who chooses
21 not to participate in a demand response program.

22 C. Upon written request, an existing customer with advanced
23 metering infrastructure (AMI) may refuse any previous AMI or demand
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1 response program offer and request replacement of AMI with an analog
2 meter, without penalty.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
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
