SENATE BILL 534

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth; amending 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-316a, which relates to heirloom birth certificates; clarifying use of certain proceeds; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-316a, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-316a. A. The State Department of Health shall provide for the issuance of an heirloom birth certificate. The Department shall design the form of the heirloom birth certificate with the advice and assistance of the Oklahoma Arts Council and may promote and sell copies of the certificate. An heirloom birth certificate shall not be used as evidence of live birth nor identification purposes.

B. The Department shall prescribe a fee for the issuance of an heirloom birth certificate in an amount that does not exceed Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00).

1 C. Proceeds from the sale of heirloom birth certificates shall  
2 be used by the ~~Child Abuse Training and Coordination Program~~ within  
3 the State Department of Health to provide child abuse prevention,  
4 training and technical assistance ~~to judges, prosecutors, and~~  
5 ~~members of multidisciplinary child abuse teams who intervene in~~  
6 ~~circumstances of child abuse.~~

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
