6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to Advanced Metering Infrastructure
8 (AMI); prohibiting installation of AMI without
9 customer request and consent; requiring opt in/out of
10 certain demand response programs without penalty;
11 requiring disclosure; providing for codification; and
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 720 of Title 17, unless there is
16 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. After the effective date of this act, a public utility shall
18 be prohibited from installing an Advanced Metering Infrastructure
19 (AMI) without the request of a residential or commercial customer
20 and a signature of such customer giving his or her informed consent
21 after being provided the disclosure information pursuant to the
22 provisions of subsection B of this section.

23 B. The required disclosure shall contain the following:

24 1. A list of possible benefits to the customer requesting an
AMI meter;

1 2. A privacy disclosure listing the amount and type of data
2 collected by an AMI meter and specific parties with whom the data
3 may be shared;

4 3. A list of the documented health side effects attributed to
5 radio-frequency radiation as documented in the Naval Medical
6 Research Institute research report, entitled "Bibliography of
7 Reported Biological Phenomena ('Effects') and Clinical
8 Manifestations Attributed to Microwave and Radio-Frequency
9 Radiation", issued October, 4, 1971; and

10 4. A statement as follows: "In some instances AMI meters have
11 overheated and ignited."

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.

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
