6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to General Educational Development
8 testing; directing the State Board of Career and
9 Technology Education to review certain passing rate;
10 directing the State Board of Career and Technology
11 Education to reconsider certain contract if certain
12 identification is made; providing for certain
13 consideration; providing for codification; providing
14 an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as 14-135 of Title 70, unless there is
18 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The State Board of Career and Technology Education shall review
20 the number of students passing the General Education Diploma (GED)
21 tests. If the State Board of Career and Technology Education
22 identifies a significant decline in the number of students passing
23 the GED test, the Board shall reconsider its GED testing contract.
24 In choosing a GED testing vendor, the Board shall ensure that the
passage rate for the GED test is not hindered by the choice in
vendor.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.

2 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
3 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
