SENATE BILL 645

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Medicaid Program; directing Oklahoma Health Care Authority to require certain results; requiring facilities to report certain results; directing promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5029 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall require quantitative, confirmatory results for chemical drug screens covered by the Oklahoma Medicaid Program. A drug screen testing facility contracting with the Authority shall report as negative all specimens which are negative on the initial test or negative on the confirmatory test.

B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.

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
