6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the State Department of Health;  
8 amending 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-316a, which relates  
9 to heirloom birth certificates; requiring submission  
of certain report; providing contents of report; and  
providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-316a, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1-316a. A. The State Department of Health shall  
16 provide for the issuance of an heirloom birth certificate. The  
17 Department shall design the form of the heirloom birth certificate  
18 with the advice and assistance of the Oklahoma Arts Council and may  
19 promote and sell copies of the certificate. An heirloom birth  
20 certificate shall not be used as evidence of live birth nor  
21 identification purposes.

22 B. The Department shall prescribe a fee for the issuance of an  
23 heirloom birth certificate in an amount that does not exceed Thirty-  
24 five Dollars (\$35.00).

1 C. Proceeds from the sale of heirloom birth certificates shall  
2 be used by the Child Abuse Training and Coordination Program within  
3 the State Department of Health to provide training and technical  
4 assistance to judges, prosecutors, and members of multidisciplinary  
5 child abuse teams who intervene in circumstances of child abuse.  
6 Beginning January 1, 2016, the Department shall submit an annual  
7 report to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of  
8 the House of Representatives describing the annual proceeds used by  
9 the Department for the provision of services authorized pursuant to  
10 this subsection.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
