6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to telemedicine; requiring
8 telemedicine services covered by Medicaid and
9 provided to patients in rural or urban areas to be
10 reimbursed at certain rate; directing promulgation of
11 rules; providing for codification; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-2704 of Title 63, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. Telemedicine services that are covered by, and reimbursed
18 under, the fee-for-service provisions of the state Medicaid program,
19 and are provided to a patient located in a rural or urban area of
20 the state, shall be reimbursed at a rate no more than eighty-five
21 percent (85%) of the usual and customary Medicaid fee schedule for
22 services.

23 B. The State Board of Health shall promulgate rules to
24 implement the provisions of this act.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
