AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Office of the Attorney General; reappropriating a certain amount of appropriations for the prosecution and defense of claims related to water and water rights in Oklahoma; making appropriations exempt from budget and category limits; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION The amount of Two Million Eight Hundred Fifty-six Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-seven Dollars (\$2,856,257.00) of the original appropriation of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00), appropriated to the Office of the Attorney General by Section 154, Chapter 311, O.S.L. 2012, from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury is hereby reappropriated for the original purpose of prosecuting and defending of claims related to water and water rights in Oklahoma. If, on the date this act is approved, any of

1 the amount originally appropriated, as adjusted by expenditures,
2 encumbrances, and transfers, results in an unencumbered balance less
3 than the reappropriated, that reappropriated amount is reduced to
4 the unencumbered amount.

5 SECTION 2. The appropriations made by this act shall not be
6 subject to fiscal year agency budget and category limitations.

7 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
8 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
