6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Adjutant General; amending 44
8 O.S. 2011, Section 232.1, which relates to the
9 leasing or renting of facilities; authorizing
10 Adjutant General to waive charges or fees in certain
11 circumstances; defining term; providing an effective
12 date; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 44 O.S. 2011, Section 232.1, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 232.1 A. The Adjutant General is authorized to enter
17 into contracts to lease or rent facilities. The Adjutant General is
18 authorized to waive all charges or fees, or any portion thereof, for
19 use of facilities by a non-profit entity when such use is in support
20 of civil authorities for joint training, natural disasters or other
21 declared emergencies in accordance with rules promulgated by the
22 Adjutant General.

23 B. As used in this title:

24 1. "Civil Authorities" means those elected and appointed
officers and employees who constitute the government of the United

1 States, the government and agencies of the State of Oklahoma, county
2 and municipal governments within the State of Oklahoma, and
3 political divisions thereof;

4 2. "Military reservations", without limitation, include
5 military installations, armories, air bases, and facilities owned or
6 controlled by the state for military purposes.

7 C. The Adjutant General shall have charge of military
8 reservations of the state and shall be responsible for the
9 protection and safety of those military reservations, and promulgate
10 rules for the maintenance of order thereon, for the enforcement of
11 traffic rules and for all other lawful rules as may be ordered for
12 the operation, care, and preservation of existing facilities and
13 installations on all state military reservations.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.

15 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
