5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Military Department;  
7 amending 44 O.S. 2011, Section 233.7, as amended by  
8 Section 155, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (44 O.S. Supp.  
9 2015, Section 233.7), which relates to the Oklahoma  
10 Military Department revolving fund; exempting certain  
11 property and equipment; providing an effective date;  
and declaring an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 44 O.S. 2011, Section 233.7, as  
14 amended by Section 155, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (44 O.S. Supp.  
15 2015, Section 233.7), is amended to read as follows:

16 Section 233.7. A. There is hereby created in the State  
17 Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Military Department to be  
18 designated the "Oklahoma Military Department Revolving Fund". The  
19 fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year  
20 limitations, and shall consist of any monies received by the  
21 Oklahoma Military Department from the sale of surplus property, fees  
22 and receipts collected pursuant to the Oklahoma Open Records Act,  
23 interagency reimbursements, federal funds unless otherwise provided  
24 by federal law or regulation, gifts, bequests, contributions,

1 devises, any other source, and the proceeds of property sold or  
2 otherwise disposed of pursuant to the provisions of subsection B of  
3 Section 233.3 of this title. All monies accruing to the credit of  
4 said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended  
5 by the Oklahoma Military Department for construction, repairs, and  
6 maintenance, equipment for facilities of the Oklahoma National  
7 Guard, or for operating expenses of the Oklahoma Military  
8 Department. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants  
9 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by  
10 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
11 Services for approval and payment. All monies in the fund may, at  
12 the direction of the Adjutant General, be invested by the State  
13 Treasurer in accordance with state investment practices. All  
14 earnings attributable to such investments shall likewise accrue to  
15 the credit of the fund.

16 B. For surplus property and equipment with a value of over One  
17 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), the Oklahoma Military Department shall  
18 be exempt from the provisions of the Oklahoma Surplus Property Act.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.

20 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
21 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
22 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
23 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
