6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Department of Human Services;
8 prohibiting Department from seeking certain waivers;
9 prohibiting Department from considering certain
standards for eligibility determination; providing
for codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 230.79 of Title 56, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. The Department of Human Services shall not seek, apply for,
17 accept or renew any waiver of the requirements provided by 7 U.S.C.,
18 Section 2015(o).

19 B. In no case shall any benefit other than cash assistance be
20 considered a benefit granting categorical eligibility pursuant to
21 the provisions of 7 U.S.C., Section 2014(a).

22 C. In no case shall the gross income standards used by the
23 Department to determine eligibility exceed those provided by 7
24 U.S.C., Section 2014(c).

1 D. In no case shall the resource limit standards used by the
2 Department to determine eligibility exceed those provided by 7
3 U.S.C., Section 2014(g) (1).

4 E. In no case shall any benefit other than cash assistance be
5 considered a benefit exempting households from the resource limits
6 provided by 7 U.S.C., Section 2014(j).

7 F. The Department shall promulgate rules to implement the
8 provisions of this section.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
