**Research Analysis**

HB 1047 adds aggravated child pornography to the list of 85% crimes. Child pornography is an existing 85% crime and the measure would include aggravated child pornography as an 85% crime.

The measure repeals Title 21, Section 1024.2 which is the punishment for buying, procuring or possessing child pornography. This is a duplicate punishment. The offenses listed are currently punished pursuant to the provisions of Title 21, Section 1021.2.
