Research Analysis

HB 1328 addresses several issues related to tort law and emergency management. The measure authorizes services of licensed architects and engineers from other states during disasters, if the individual receives a temporary license in Oklahoma. The measure also reduces liability for licensed architects and engineers who voluntarily produce risk-assessment reports. Next, the measure provides a process for inspecting public or private buildings in the event of damage or collapse due to disaster. Lastly, the measure limits the terms “safe room” and “storm shelter” to shelters that meet or exceed FEMA and International Code Council guidelines, respectively.
