**Research Analysis**

HB 1353, as introduced, creates the Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise Act. It would give a bonus preference of 3 points to businesses owned or controlled by service-disabled veterans. This would apply to all state agencies, departments, and political subdivisions of the state in awarding contracts for any job or service.

The Director of OMES would have a goal of 3% of all such contracts to be awarded to service-disabled veterans and their businesses.
