Research Analysis

HB 1382 authorizes the forfeiture of money and property used in the course of or derived from a violation of the Oklahoma Antiterrorism Act. Allows a person who is injured as a result of a criminal offense under the Oklahoma Antiterrorism Act to sue for damages against the person who violated the Act and allows for the recovery of treble damages or \$10,000, whichever is greater.
