Research Analysis

HB 1402 provides that no participant in a Rural Fire Protection Program is to receive financial assistance merely for the purpose of accumulation. Any financial assistance not expended by a participant on or before the last day of April following the grant of financial assistance is to be returned to the Department of Agriculture for redistribution to other participants in need of financial assistance. The measure allows financial assistance to be distributed to participants by electronic transfer of funds. The measure provides that eligible participants include only incorporated cities under 10,000 population, towns, and rural fire departments formed legally and maintained under state law.
