Research Analysis

HB 1405 creates a separate fee for disposing drinking water treatment residuals (filter backwash water, clarifier blow-off, etc.) in underground injection wells. The fee is between \$2,000 and \$5,000.

Fiscal Analysis

After review and consultation with the Department of Environmental Quality, it is determined that HB1405 has no fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.

HB1405 decreases the fee that a public water supply provider, such as a municipality or rural water district, would pay to dispose by underground injection of residuals resulting from the treatment of drinking water. Currently, no public water supply injects its drinking water treatment residuals into Class V injection wells.
