**Research Analysis**

HB 1462 exempts agricultural producers from burn bans, if the producer submits his/her plan to the local fire department; notifies the sheriff prior to conducting the burn; conducts prescribed burns in accordance with rules set forth by the Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; and does not burn debris.
