**Research Analysis**

Introduced HB1599 creates the Preservation of Sovereignty and Marriage Act which prohibits taxpayer funds, including governmental salaries, to be used for any activity that supports same-sex marriage. A court must dismiss any case to challenge the act and award attorney fees to the defendant or face removal from the office pursuant to the removal procedures outlined in state constitution.
