**Fiscal Analysis**

Per OHCA, the fiscal impact would be dependent upon cost multiplied by number of tests performed, however per OHCA, there is minimal exposure with this bill because it doesn't limit their ability to prior authorize any of these tests.

HB 1628 FA3 directs OHCA to implement agreements with labs that provide comprehensive testing. HB 1628 FA3 caps the agreements with labs to no more than \$3.7 million per year.
