The Senate Amendment to HB 1651 exempts persons using non-lethal, non-chemical capture or restraint of animals on commercial hunt areas for management, viewing or photographic purposes from the prohibition against using traps, bait and other implements.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The Senate amendment on HB 1651 adds “any person using non-lethal, non-chemical capture or restraint of animals on licensed commercial hunt areas for management, viewing or photographic purposes” to the list of exempted entities from using the killing or capturing methods prohibited in the bill. This has no fiscal or revenue considerations to the state.
