Research Analysis

As introduced, the measure modifies the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act. The measure adds the Workers' Compensation Commission to the list of public bodies that are authorized to hold executive sessions for the following purposes:

- if the Commission is sitting en banc, deliberating on appeals of cases or other disputes arising from actions of the Commission, provided votes of the Commission must be cast in open meeting and recorded in any order issued;
- for discussion of budgets, internal reports and the setting of agendas, provided no action is taken; or
- if members of the Commission are attending any conference, training program or informational presentation.
