**Fiscal Analysis**

After consultation with the Liquefied Petroleum Administration, HB 1751 does have an impact on their revenue. If the Appliance Dealer permit is struck, the board loses \$26,110 per year. If the Cylinder Exchange is limited to one permit per entity instead of one per store, they receive \$50.00 x 207 Dealers (\$10,350), instead of \$50.00 x 1847 stores (\$92,350), resulting in a yearly loss of \$82,000. Combining the Appliance Dealer loss with the Cylinder Exchange, total yearly loss is \$108,110.
