**Research Analysis**

The CS for HB 1763 directs the State Board of Education to establish a definition for the term *provisional diploma*.

HB 1763 requires each school district board of education to adopt a grading policy for all students in the district. Additionally, the measure allows students who do not attain a proficient score on certain EOI tests, after three attempts, to graduate with a provisional diploma.
