Research Analysis

HB 1774 creates a three-day wildlife conservation passport for \$15 for use on lands owned by the Wildlife Conservation Commission. The measure also provides a substitute license in lieu of posting bond for a person who is arrested without a passport. The substitute license is \$50 for residents and \$90 for nonresidents.
