**Research Analysis**

The Senate Amendment to HB 1834 clarifies some language in the engrossed bill and changes from 72 hours to 3 judicial days during which time an American Indian tribe or nation is to be notified that a child with that ancestry is in the custody of the Office of Juvenile Affairs.
