Research Analysis

HB 1854, as introduced, requires out of state agencies that advertise adoption services or solicit birth mothers for adoption in Oklahoma to contract with DHS or a child placing agency to place a child for adoption in the state. The measure also restricts the use of the terms “adoption counseling services” and “adoption counseling” in advertisements and solicitations to child placing agencies and requires all adoption-related counseling expenses and living expenses be paid through a child placing agency directly to the third-party provider of the services.
