Research Analysis

Introduced HB2214 modifies the appointment procedures for the six attorney members of the Judicial Nominating Commission (JNC). Beginning November 1, 2015, the terms of those currently serving as an attorney member on the JNC will terminate and new appointments will be made by the Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General and Bar Association as follows:

-two members, one appointed from Congressional District (CD) 1 by the Lieutenant Governor and one appointed from CD 2 by the Attorney General, for an initial term of two years;

-two members, one appointed from CD 3 by the Lieutenant Governor and one appointed from CD 4 by the Attorney General, for an initial term of four years; and

-two members, one appointed from CD 5 and one appointed from CD 6 by the Oklahoma Bar Association for an initial term of six years.
