HJR 1032 disapproves proposed permanent rules of the Department of Environmental Quality.

Agency summary:

The rules of this Chapter proposed for revocation provided standards for the accreditation of privately and publicly owned laboratories for performance of analyses of water and wastewater, solid and hazardous waste, soil, sludge and petroleum hydrocarbons and applied to laboratories accredited or applying to be accredited by the Department of Environmental Quality were intended to be consistent with The NELAC Institute (TNI) standards. However, this chapter, which has never become effective, is being revoked due to inconsistency with TNI Standards language and difficulty in enforcing the chapter as written.

This rule revocation process is progressing in tandem with the adoption of a new Chapter 307, TNI Laboratory Accreditation.
