Research Analysis

SB 135 is an omnibus bill for the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training. The measure provides that a certified copy of the information or indictment charging a crime shall be considered clear and convincing evidence of the charge and can be used to suspend the certification of a peace officer. The measure provides that prior to employment, an employing entity must determine if the applicant for a peace officer position has criminal charges pending in any court. The measure provides that CLEET is to revoke the certification of any person who has entered into an “Alford” plea or any other plea other than a not guilty plea. The measure prohibits employees of CLEET from being involved in the training or testing of canine teams. The measure provides that CLEET is not to be a party to any court action based on a law enforcement agency seeking reimbursement for providing training to a person who resigns and is hired by another law enforcement agency. The measure provides that all CLEET records of Bail Enforcers may be released only in compliance with this section and the Oklahoma Bail Enforcement and Licensing Act. All records in CLEET possession concerning other persons or entities shall be released only in compliance with the Oklahoma Open Records Act. The measure requires any person who applies to the reserve basic law enforcement academy to score a minimum of 70% on a reading and writing comprehension exam
