Research Analysis

SB 172 amends the Oklahoma Employees Insurance and Benefits Act. The measure provides that OMES shall propose health plans that incentivize participants to purchase services from providers that have posted their prices online. The bill also prevents reimbursements to health care providers that are for more than the amount of the service, if the amount can be found on the provider's online pricing.
