Research Analysis

SB 255 creates a definition of “autocycle” as used in the Motor Vehicle Code and requires autocycles to be registered as a motor vehicle. An autocycle is defined to mean any motor vehicle with a seat or saddle for each rider and three wheels in contact with the ground. An autocycle must also have an engine with at least 150cc of displacement and a fully enclosed compartment for the driver and passenger with appropriate safety equipment. The measure also states that the operator of an autocycle is not required to have a motorcycle endorsement to operate an autocycle.
