Research Analysis

SB 262 directs the State Department of Education, in collaboration with the Oklahoma Department of Labor, to make available to school districts information regarding workplace safety training for grades seven through twelve. School districts will be encouraged to inform teachers in grades seven through twelve about the importance of incorporating workplace safety training in their curriculum.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure requires the State Department of Education (SDE) to make workplace safety training information available to districts for grades seven through twelve, and specifies inclusion of curriculum provided by the Department of Labor. According to the Dept. of Labor, the curriculum mentioned in the measure (“Youth @ Work Talking Safety: A Safety and Health Curriculum for Young Workers”) is free, thus resulting in no impact to SDE. There may be costs associated with additional resources chosen by SDE, and the agency is currently researching these options.
