**Research Analysis**

SB 326 removes from the chapter references to the office of state fuel inspector. The fuel storage and measuring device inspections are to be completed by Corporation Commission employees. The measure also modifies the penalties for a noncompliance or a tampering conviction related to fuel storage and measurement and refers to penalties established in Title 17 (Corporation Commission). The measure repeals three sections related to penalties and recodifies the amended sections as part of Chapter 5 (Inspections) of Title 52 (Oil and Gas).
