**Research Analysis**

SB 366 creates the Oklahoma Veteran Housing Program. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs would be directed to develop a housing grant, not to exceed \$5,000 per veteran, to go toward costs of homes specifically designed for disabled veterans.

**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 366 calls for a \$5,000 grant for disabled veterans who qualify under the Federal program for home renovations or construction. The bill also includes the provision “subject to the availability of funds”. Currently ODVA has \$170,000 budgeted for Financial Assistance and has 170 veterans budgeted at \$1,000 each.
