Research Analysis

The measure modifies definitions used in the Oklahoma Electronic Toll Collection Act to provide for a video toll collection system. A video toll collection system means a photo-monitoring system used to charge and collect tolls from owners of vehicles imaged using the turnpike system. The measure prohibits the Turnpike Authority from making the names and addresses of video toll collection system account holders available without the consent of the account holder.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure, if approved, provides an opportunity for the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority (OTA) to collect tolls using fully automated means (known as all electronic tolling, or AET), thus eliminating the need for cash collection at various points. OTA reports using an interchange at Peoria/Elm and the Creek Turnpike in Jenks as a pilot project for this effort. OTA estimates the use of AET at the pilot project site to potentially yield savings of \$6 million per year for the agency.
